

Report an Incident

The university takes all allegations of discrimination and harassment seriously and is committed to thoroughly investigating and resolving any alleged instance(s) of which it becomes aware, including taking necessary corrective action to stop the offending conduct, and proactive steps to prevent its recurrence.

Any student who believes he or she, or another student, has been subjected to sexual discrimination or harassment, including sexual assault or physical violence, by another member of the campus community, or by any other person in the course of a Fresno State-sponsored event, program or activity, should immediately report the incident to the campus' Title IX Coordinator, Associate Vice President of Human Resources:
