Submission Guidelines

All submissions must be original and not simultaneously submitted to another conference.

Abstracts are invited for 20-minute talks (with 10 minutes for discussion) on any aspect of theoretical or descriptive linguistics.

Abstracts must be limited to 500 words, excluding references. The format of the abstract should follow the guidelines below:

- Title centered at top of page, in bold
- Word count at the end of the abstract
- Anonymous: authors' names and affiliations should not be indicated anywhere in the abstract
- File name: **title.pdf**
