## **Policy on Committee Meetings**

- 1. All graduate students must complete a mandatory committee meeting in at least the semester PRIOR to the intended semester of graduation to secure approval from the thesis committee for thesis submission. This meeting is intended to be a presentation of data/results/analyses the student has obtained to determine whether enrolling in BIOL 299 is appropriate. The deadline for these meetings will coincide with the thesis submission deadlines established by Division of Graduate Studies for that specific semester (usually Oct 31 in Fall and April 1 in Spring semesters).
- 2. All graduate students are expected to organize a review each semester with their committee members to discuss research and programmatic progress, and these summaries will be placed in your departmental file as part of your future evaluation. These meetings ought to occur by October 15 and March 15 of the fall and spring semester, respectively.
