Visual and Performing Arts Requirement: Selection of a visual and performing arts course in the major (ART 179, MUSIC 153, DRAMA 136, 137 or DANCE 160) must be from a discipline that is different from that taken to meet GE Area C1.

Electives and remaining degree requirements (units varies): May be used to satisfy Multiple Subject or Education Specialist Credential Program requirements. Students must earn a minimum of 120 units total to graduate. The number of required elective units may vary, depending on the amount of units earned from major and GE courses.

*Liberal Studies majors who plan to obtain a credential should attend an orientation by signing up in the Education Student Services Center in ED 100 during the semester prior to entering the credential program.

Substitutions: If substitutions/exceptions/waivers are made for any major courses that also meet GE and/or the Multicultural/International graduation requirement, the student is responsible for completing additional courses to satisfy the respective areas (GE and/or MI). This also includes the upper division writing requirement.
