The ideal candidates will have a positive attitude, a great work ethic, and an attention detail. The candidate should be able to work long daily shifts and be prepared to work up to 6 days a week.

**Viticulture duties:**

- Attend Vineyard/Winemaking meetings
- Monitor Grape Maturity through sampling
- Flagging Vines
- Tending to the estate garden and surrounding property

**Cellar/Enology duties:**

- Processing grape maturity samples for analysis
- Perform lab analysis including but not limited to - Brix, pH/TA, Y15 Analysis, Fining/Addition Trials
- Collect tank and barrel samples throughout processing
- Cellar work may include: sanitation; bottling line work; additions to must/juice; barrel stirring; forklifting; topping; racking/blending
- Forklift Certified preferred but not required

- Able to stand for long periods of time
