The primary responsibility of the candidate may include:

- Farm Management
 - Work with all levels of the farm team to ensure proper ranch management
 - Contribute operations information
 - Improve operational management systems and processes
 - Support the overall success of the ranch
- Field Production and Operations
 - Check fields for season-specific orchard tasks assigned by PCA
 - Keep detailed records of orchard checks
 - In-season trapping deployment
 - Weekly checks and summary reports
 - Coordinate with applicators to ensure recommendations are closed in a timely fashion
 - Report issues with chemical recommendations to PCA
- Project Management
 - Each Intern will be responsible for exploring and gathering data related to an area where process improvement is needed
 - The Intern will work with the farm team to learn about the current state and resources available
 - During the duration of the internship the Intern will be responsible for execution and implementation of their project across the ranch
