

Winemaking Internship for Wineco Inc. Kelseyville CA

Wineco Inc is a large bulk wine production facility in Kelseyville CA, Lake County. This season the winery will process several thousand tons. The majority of the wine produced is destined for the bulk wine market. The internship experience here will expose the student/recent graduate to many aspects of bulk wine production from fermentation through preparation for shipping. The winery produces red, white, and rose varietal wines from several CA appellations.

The requirements for this internship are as follows:

- Ability to start as soon as possible, preferably before June 15th, 2021 and be able to work through December 31, 2021. There is a possibility that this internship could evolve into a permanent position
- The intern should have/or be pursuing a Bachelor's degree or Certificate in Enology
- The intern should live or be willing to relocate to within 1 hour drive from Kelseyville, CA
- Ability to work in loud production environment, walk/stand for extended periods, lift 50#, work outside in the elements
- The intern should have experience with WMDB or other winery production software or at least the technical aptitude necessary to use them.
- Be able to sort, collate, and enter data into a database
- Be able to work extended and non-conventional hours and work weeks, including over-time when necessary
- The intern should be English/Spanish bi-lingual or have better than basic Spanish comprehension
- This position requires multi-tasking and often basic decision making in the absence of the Winemaker
- The intern will need exceptional wine chemistry knowledge, including testing and calculations necessary for remediation
- The intern may occasionally be asked to work outside the winery environment
- Must possess a valid Driver's License and be legally able to work in the United States
