## What is the Fresno Teacher Residency Program?

The Fresno Teacher Residency Program is a joint effort between Fresno Unified School District and Fresno State. The overarching goal of the FTRP is to improve student achievement in science, technology, math and science in grades K-12 through innovative, cutting edge teacher preparation program coupled with outstanding professional support.

### Program Design:

- Receive a Teaching Credential from Fresno State
- Apprenticeship in a classroom with a mentor team
- Early continuous clinical field experiences
- Comprehensive professional learning opportunities
- Focus on State Standards, Next Generation Science Standards, Accountable Communities, Assessment for Learning and Safe & Civil Schools
- Creation of a culture of collaboration and reflective learning
- Fresno Unified employment upon successful completion

### Program Support:

- Cohort model of learning
- 25 Teacher Residents in each cohort
- Co-teaching opportunities with mentor teacher
- Required coursework co-taught by University Faculty and Fresno Unified Staff
- Residents receive an \$11,500 stipend during the program
- Opportunity to receive Bilingual Authorization
