PURPOSE: To guide students seeking help for Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD) symptoms.

POLICY: Effective Spring 2018, The Student Health and Counseling Center (SHCC) will no longer write prescriptions for ADHD medications.

Students in need of ADHD medication may seek care through an outside physician.

While the Student Health and Counseling Center does not have the resources to evaluate for or treat ADHD, we would like to help you find the resources that you need.
