Academic excellence and athletic accomplishments go hand-in-hand at Fresno State. Fresno State is a Division I member of the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) and the Mountain West (MW).

To assist with the overall development of student-athletes, the Student-Athlete Services Office provides tutoring, academic advising, guidance and counseling, and NCAA eligibility monitoring for student-athletes on a year-round basis.

Excellent facilities exist for Fresno State Athletics. Bulldog Stadium features a 41,031 seat capacity. Beiden Field, the baseball stadium, seats 5,422; Bulldog Diamond, the softball complex, has a capacity of 3,288. The Save Mart Center, home of volleyball and men's and women's basketball, is a 13-story facility with 16,000 seats. Facilities exist for track and field, tennis, and golf. In addition, student-athletes have the use of two gymnasiums, modern locker rooms, and a \$5 million Strength and Conditioning Center. The Ricchiuti Academic Center is a first-class, state-of-the-art facility serving more than 400 Bulldog student-athletes. It includes study and computer labs, office space for Student-Athlete Services and Compliance personnel and meeting rooms.
