Emails were received/exchanged regarding the *transferability* of an OBE/APM206 approved course to another (suitably trained) instructor. The pre-pandemic assumption had been that the proposal was specific to the instructor. Departments could choose for a proposal to be instructor-specific or re-assignable. The existing APM is not clear on this.

ECON40 Principles of Microeconomics (V. Van Vleck) QLT24 reviewed, post-review consultation completed, awaiting QLT Amendment form documentation suggestions/recommendations/ responses. M/S/C-pending timely (2 weeks) receipt of instructor's QLT Amendment form.

Multiple reviews in progress; issue of Canvas assignment/access noted.

Consider putting through a survey regarding faculty (& student?) experiences of cheating during virtual instruction due to the pandemic. Follow data collection a la the “doping scandals” from international cycling/athletics. Bernadette recommended/noted that the OIE has prepared survey mechanisms to provide an appropriate sample of the populations without inundating everyone’s emails with survey requests. Necessary consultation with Faculty Affairs and Student Affairs noted.

Encouraged starting to think about the needed APM206 revisions/clarifications, but deferred until the QLT-reviews backlog and the impending April 1 curriculum deadline priorities are dealt with. For future work.
